Dunkerton Parents-

Last night, Gov. Reynolds recommended Iowa schools close for four weeks. This situation continues to be very fluid, so you can expect to receive periodic communication from the Dunkerton School District through text messages, emails, the District's website and social media platforms. We do plan to have the district closed for the next four weeks.

Length of Cancellation: Currently, school will be cancelled until April 13th.

Make-up Days: Currently, we don't have guidance from the state on whether we will need to make up missed days. At this time, we are not planning on having online learning. One of our main obstacles is getting access to the internet for all students.

Building Closed: The building (including the fitness center) will be closed over the next four weeks. We need to keep people out of the building to keep it as safe as possible. Office staff will be contacting families to pick up any medications that are at school. If your child needs something from school, you should contact the office ahead of time to schedule a time to pick up items. Office staff will bring your child's items to the school door to be picked up.

School Activities: All school activities are cancelled or postponed for the next four weeks. This includes any extra-curricular activities, community groups, youth sports and Preschool round up. We hope to be able to reschedule as many activities as possible when we are back in session. Drivers Education classes have been suspended as well.

Meal program: The district is working on providing "grab and go" meals during the time off. We are waiting on final approval from the State before we launch. We anticipate both a "drive through" pick up at school and a delivery option for families.
