**May Book Club: *The Tree Grows in Brooklyn* by Betty Smith**

This PBS Great American Read Top 100 Pick and beloved American classic is about a young girl's coming-of-age at the turn of the twentieth century. From the moment she entered the world, Francie Nolan needed to be made of stern stuff to endure the often harsh life of growing up in the Williamsburg slums of Brooklyn, New York. Often scorned by neighbors for her family's erratic and eccentric behavior—such as her father Johnny's taste for alcohol and Aunt Sissy's habit of marrying serially without the formality of divorce—no one, least of all Francie, could say that the Nolans' life lacked drama. Betty Smith has captured the Nolans' overwhelming, heart-breaking, and uplifting daily experiences as well as the joys of humble Williamsburg life. Here is an American classic that "cuts right to the heart of life," hails the New York Times. "If you miss *A Tree Grows in Brooklyn*, you will
