RE: Continuation of the Summer Food Service Program

Dunkerton Families:

Starting September 22, 2020 the Dunkerton Community School District will be participating in the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) that the USDA recently extended. This program is scheduled to run until Federal funds run out or at the latest, December 31, 2020..

All Dunkerton students enrolled in Preschool through 12th grade program are eligible for free meals; breakfast and lunch. We will serve students on site and continue with Grab and Go meals for our Hybrid students who have signed up.

Anything outside of the standard meal served, including extra milk, yogurt, or second trips will be charged to the student account. You must have a positive balance in the account for these items to be served.

When Federal funds run out, we will go back to the National School Breakfast and Lunch programs and students will be charged for meals according to their eligibility. Therefore, it is extremely important for families who qualify for meal assistance, to complete the necessary paperwork to maintain your eligibility. If you do not, you will lose your Federal assistance once this special Federal funding is gone.
