

Dunkerton CSD: District ESSER III Plan

On April 21, 2021, the U.S. Department of Education (USED) released its American Rescue Plan Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (ARP ESSER or ESSER III) for state education agencies (SEAs) to complete to receive the remaining third of ESSER III funds. In addition, the USED also released final requirements related to district ESSER III plans and district plans for a safe return to in-person instruction and continuity of services. Each district receiving ESSER III funds must:

- Develop a plan regarding its proposed uses of ESSER III funds, including engaging in meaningful consultation with all required stakeholders and providing the public opportunity to provide comments during plan development.
- Submit an ESSER III plan to the Department through the Consolidated Accountability and Support Application (CASA).
- Make the plan publicly available on its website in an understandable and accessible format.

The District has received \$358,523 in ESSERIII Funds. Of that funding, 20% or \$71,705 is required to go to help remediate learning loss.
